

More Facts about Illegal Aliens Invasion

It is reasonable to state that at least 20 million illegal aliens reside in the United States. (Desert Invasion...U.S.)

Illegal aliens displaced American workers at a cost of \$133 billion dollars in 2003. Hispanic and Black Americans most hurt by influx of illegal aliens. (Harvard Professor George Borjac, considered a leading authority on impact of Immigration.)

High School students are displaced by illegal aliens who work at a third the wage in typical student summer jobs, such as yard care, landscape, fast food, or service jobs. (Frosty Wooldridge)

There are 18 Million Americans who cannot find a job. Labor plan for major corporations-bust your unions and do not offer a living wage so that Americans can take the job. (Liz Michael)

Corporations devour cheap labor. They pay PAC groups to keep Senators and Congressmen in their back pocket. Only 22 companies in 2003 were taken to court for hiring illegal aliens. None went to jail. (Frosty Wooldridge)

In 2003, illegal aliens stole 57,600 cars in Phoenix, Az. Owner loses exceeded \$864 million dollars! (Az. Department of Motor Vehicles.)

Seventy-five percent of drugs arrive from Mexico annually at a net cost of \$128 billion dollars hard currency that leaves our country for good. (Frosty Wooldridge)

U.S. Spends \$80 billion dollars on war on drugs each year. (Frosty Wooldridge)

Illegal aliens fill 33 percent of our federal and state prisons. (Liz Michael)

You pay \$1.6 billion dollars annually in prison costs to house, feed, clothe illegal aliens criminals. (Frosty Wooldridge)

\$60 billion dollars are earned by illegal aliens in the U.S. Each year. (Colorado Alliance for Immigration Reform)

One-third to one-half illegal aliens work off the books. (Frosty Wooldridge)

Mexican and Latin American Immigrants and illegal aliens sent \$38 billion dollars to their home countries. (May 28, 2004 study by Benedixen & Associates) Mexico receives \$13.3 billion dollars a year. (September 25, 2002 NPR Report) That figures to what Mexico earns annually from tourism. This is a massive transfer of wealth from America's displaced working poor to Mexico. (Colorado Alliance for Immigration Reform)

Thirty-Six to forty-two percent illegal aliens are on welfare. (None Dare Call it Treason. Liz Michael. January, 2004)

Average Illegal alien cost to U.S. Taxpayer, a whopping \$55,000 dollars each. (The Center for Immigration Studies)

The total k-12 school expenditure for illegal aliens cost the states \$7.4 billion dollars annually.

(Federation for Immigration Reform)

With minimum of 15 million illegal aliens in our country, average bilingual education is \$1,200 dollars per illegal alien student. (Frosty Wooldridge)

You paid \$27 billion dollars to provide forms, ballots, interpreters and brochures for languages other than English in 2003. (Frosty Wooldridge)

Over 30,000 illegal alien pregnant women cross our borders and give birth to alien anchor babies. Cost per child for food, housing, medical and schooling or them to age 18, plus their mother, exceeds \$109 billion dollars annually. (Center for Immigration Studies)

It costs U.S. \$200 million dollars annually to provide emergency health care for illegal aliens in border states. (Frosty Wooldridge)

California with over three million illegal aliens paid \$79 million dollars for emergency health care. Four of the L.A. Hospitals bankrupted and closed their doors in 2004. (Frosty Wooldridge)

Texas with 1.5 million illegal aliens paid \$74 million dollars in hospital care. (Frosty Wooldridge)

You may not live in these states, but you the taxpayer, still pay commensurate medical care according to your illegal alien population. (Frosty Wooldridge)

Illegal aliens are importing eradicated diseases and new diseases into the U.S. (Population-Environment Balance uspop@us.net Home www.balance.org)

Newly imported diseases by illegal aliens include: tuberculosis, sickle cell anemia, hepatitis B, measles, and a parasitic disease called chagas. (Population-Environment balance)

In 2002, Sheriff Larry Dever, Cochise County, Az, testified to a Senate Subcommittee on immigration that a surge of illegal aliens who came through his county, has damaged or destroyed water resources and public property, and that

land is now littered with tons of garbage, clothing, and human waste. (Desert Invasion U.S. Diana Hull, Ph. D. 2002)

U.S. District Attorney for the District of Arizona, Jose de Jesus Rivera, described to a Senate Subcommittee, problems with home invasions, burglaries, slaughter of livestock, draining of water systems, and huge quantities of refuse left by illegal aliens. He also warned about increasing band of “drug backpackers” who cross private property in groups carrying firearms. (Desert Invasion U.S. Diana Hull. Ph. D. 2003)

Illegal Aliens have caused wild fires in publicly owned resources. Jike Oregon Pipe Cactus National Monument, the Coronado National Forest and the San Pedro Riparian Conservation Area. (Desert Invasion-U.S. Diana Hull, Ph. D. 2003)

Jesse Juen, Bureau of land Management field representative in Tucson, told Senate Subcommittee that wildfires caused by illegal aliens smoking and trying to keep warm destroyed about twenty percent of the riparian vegetation along the San Pedro River in Cochise County, that off road vehicles of alien smugglers often go down steep embankments and motor oil and fuel leaks into the streams and endanger species habitat. (Diana Hull, Ph. D. 2002)

James Bellamy, Superintendent of the Coronado National Monument in southeastern Arizona told the Senate Subcommittee that human foot traffic as created trails the width of roads. Vegetation is trampled to such an extent that steep hillsides have been eroded and much ground laid bare with widespread-like discarded clothing, blankets, food containers, toilet paper, and human excrement. (Desert Invasion-U.S. Diana Hull, Ph. D. 2002)

Some of these figures have certainly increased, Example, according to Madeline Pelter Cosman, author of a report on illegal aliens in the spring issue of the Journal of American Physicians and Surgeons, “84 California hospitals are closing their doors as a direct result of the rising number of illegal aliens and their non-reimbursed tax on the system.”
