## How Liberty Dies: The Patriot Reauthorization Act by John W. Whitehead

Do our representatives understand how we feel? Or don't they care? The recent approval by the Senate Intelligence Committee to reauthorize and expand the Patriot Act's powers leaves one wondering if Congress listens to the American people anymore.

Equally worrisome is the fact that the critical discussions and decisions surrounding expansion of the Act are taking place in secret, behind closed doors. What do our government representatives have to hide?

Since the passage of the Patriot Act six weeks after the 9/11 terrorist attacks, 378 local and county governments and seven state legislatures representing millions of Americans have passed resolutions or ordinances opposing aspects of the Patriot Act that they believe to be at odds with the United States Constitution. One City Council member from Arcata, Calif., described his town's ordinance as "a nonviolent preemptive attack" on the federal government's revision of the Bill of Rights.

Yet our government continues to ignore these concerns and push through its own agenda.

At a massive 342 pages, the Patriot Act violates at least six of the ten original amendments known as the Bill of Rights—the First, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Amendments—and possibly the Thirteenth and Fourteenth as well.

The Patriot Act was rushed through Congress, even though the majority of our representatives admitted to not reading it, reassured perhaps by the inclusion of a five-year sunset provision. But that sun does not seem to be setting

on this chilling piece of legislation. Instead, the Senate Intelligence Committee is not only working to make the Patriot Act permanent, but also to expand its reach.

Among some of the widely cited concerns about the Patriot Act are that it redefines terrorism so broadly that many non-terrorist political activities such as protest marches or demonstrations and civil disobedience can be considered a terrorist act; grants the FBI the right to come to your place of employment, demand your personal records and question your supervisors and fellow employees, all without notifying you; allows the government access to your medical records, school records and practically every personal record about you; allows the government to secretly demand to see records of books or magazines you've checked out in any public library and Internet sites you've visited (at least 545 libraries received such demands in the first year following passage of the Patriot Act); and most egregious of all, it allows the FBI to enter your home through the use of a special warrant, search your personal effects and confiscate your personal property without informing you that they have done so.

Yet despite the many objections to these disturbing provisions within the Patriot Act, the Senate Intelligence Committee has wholeheartedly embraced the Patriot Reauthorization Act (PAREA), which takes government intrusion into the lives of average Americans to a whole new level.

For example, one "administrative authority" provision within PAREA, which would allow the FBI to write and approve its own search orders, represents a direct assault on the Fourth Amendment's prohibitions against unreasonable search and seizure.

Yet if Congress acts to approve what critics have termed "carte blanche for a fishing expedition," the FBI will be in a position to conduct warrantless searches on people without having to show any evidence that they may be involved in criminal activities. This provision would also lift one of the last restrictions on special warrants for the

FBI—namely, that the information be related to international terrorism or foreign intelligence.

Yet while government officials insist that the FBI needs additional tools to fight terrorism, a recent report suggests that all the FBI really needs to do is its job. A Justice Department report reveals that the same FBI that wants to do an end-run around our Constitution passed up on at least five chances in the months before 9/11 to locate two terrorist hijackers as they prepared for attacks on our country. The oversights were attributed to communication breakdowns, lack of urgency and bureaucratic obstacles, among other things. "What we found were sufficient deficiencies in the way the FBI handled these issues," said Inspector General Glenn Fine. In other words, if the FBI and other intelligence agencies had simply done their jobs and followed up on leads, then there wouldn't have been a need for the Patriot Act—and there certainly wouldn't be a need for warrantless searches.

While it remains questionable whether the Patriot Act has really succeeded in protecting Americans against future acts of terrorism, these highly controversial additions to the Act will unquestionably succeed in gutting the Fourth Amendment. Of all the protections found in the Constitution, the Fourth Amendment stands as the final barrier between the privacy rights of

Americans and the potential for government abuse of power. But if law enforcement officials can search your home and your records without having to go through a judge, then the concept of a man's home being his castle will become as antiquated as the Model T.

Despite the fact that an increasing number of Americans are voicing their concerns about intrusions on their privacy, President Bush continues to express his support for extending the Patriot Act. One day after the 9/11 terrorist attacks, Bush declared, "We will not allow this enemy to win the war by changing our way of life or restricting our freedoms." Yet if Congress succeeds in continuing to pass legislation that is at

odds with our Constitution, we will have handed a definitive victory to our enemies by allowing unchecked police power to triumph over individual rights and the rule of law in this country.

At that point, our government will be no better than the dictatorships we have for so long opposed on principled grounds.

In a Jan. 2003 interview with the Los Angeles Times, constitutional law professor Jonathan Turley remarked, "Since 9/11, the Constitution has gone from an objective to be satisfied to an obstacle to national defense... As these changes mount, at what point do we become something other than a free and democratic nation?"

Americans would do well to heed the warning behind Turley's words: with every piece of Patriot Act-type legislation that Congress passes, our basic constitutional protections are being undermined and we are, indeed, moving further away from being a free and democratic nation.

To quote a recent editorial, "Is this how liberty dies?" For the sake of this great nation, I hope not.

We used to revere the heroes of bygone days for their lack of apparent fear in the face of danger. ## "Freedom from Income Taxes a given under the constitution"

Dear Mr. Chief Justice:

An overview of the Internal Revenue Service, what it knows about the courts rulings, what they do not allow you to present, how they try to stop and discourage you from both presenting the facts and making the rulings of the courts apply to the Internal Revenue Service.

The IRS tax code is merely a front to steel and defraud the citizens of this nation from their money, property, lives and future.

The administrative section will not allow you to discuss your case or present a reason for you not to pay income taxes. They believe every American should pay income taxes, even though the United States Supreme Court has ruled them "Unconstitutional", *Pollock v. Farmers' Loan and Trust Co.* 157 U.S. 429, 158 U.S. 601. I did go on the Internet this week and now find this case is actually mentioned in the tax code. When you read it however it merely omits the fact that the High Court ruled "income taxes" unconstitutional. In the index to code under income tax there is no reference to either this case nor the courts decision that "Income Taxes are "Unconstitutional".

*Stanton v Baltic Mining Co.*, 240 U.S. 103, that wages are not income within the meaning of the income tax Amendment to the Constitution, or any other provision of the Constitution. Far be it for the criminals in the Internal Revenue Service, the Department of Justice and those who write the tax codes to ever include the above definitions in the index to the code. Find it?

The United States Supreme Court held that Congress cannot by any definition it may adopt conclude what "income" is, since it cannot by legislation alter the Constitution, from which alone it derives its power to legislate, and within whose limitations alone that power can be lawfully exercised. (*Eisner v. Macomber*, 252 U/S 189, 206 (1920) Have you looked at the IRS code book lately?

The United States Supreme Court has defined the term income for the purposes of all income tax legislation as: The gain derived from capital, from labor or from both combined, provided it include profit gained through a sale or conversion of capital assets. (*Stratton's Indep v. Howbert*, 231 U.S.399 (1913) *Doyle v. Mitchell*, 247 U.S. 179 (1920) *South Pacific v. Lowe*, 247 U.S. 330 (1918) *Eisner v. Macomber*, 252 U.S.189 (1920) *Merchant's Loan v. Smietanka*, 255 U.S. 509 (1921).

The United States Supreme Court defined "income to mean the following: "Whatever difficulty there may be about a precise scientific definition of "income," it imports, as used here, something

entirely distinct from principal or capital either as a subject of taxation or as a measure of the tax; conveying rather the idea of gain or increase arising from corporate activities.”  
Doyle v. Mitchell Brothers Co., 247 U.S. 179, 185, 38 S.Ct. 467 (1918) (emphasis added)

The court decided in the Pollock Case that the income tax law of 1894 amounted in effect to a direct tax upon property, and was invalid because not apportioned according to the populations, as prescribed by the Constitution. The act of 1909 avoided this difficulty by imposing not an income tax, but an excise tax upon the conduct of business in a corporate capacity, measuring however, the amount of tax by the income of the corporation...  
Flint v. Stone Tracy Co. 220 U.S. 107, 55 L. Ed 389, 31 Sup. Ct. Rep. 342. Ann. Cas.”

(See Stratton’s Independence v. Howbert 231 U.S. 399, 414, 58 L. Ed. 285, 34 Sup. Ct. 136 (1913) (Emphasis added)

In all tax acts of Congress the meaning of income must remain the same: Income is the result of Corporate Activity.

The term “corporation” as used above infers a federally chartered and not a state chartered corporation. The United States Government is defined as a federal corporation: United States Code - Title 28; Part IV; Chapter 176; Subchapter A; Sec. 3002 - Definitions (15) “United States” means - (A) a Federal Corporation; (B) an agency, department, commission, board, or other entity of the United States; or (C) an instrumentality of the United States.

(See 26 U.S.C. 3002) Unless a citizen files and obtains a corporate status he or she is not either a state or federal corporation and therefore cannot have “profit” or “gain” as constitutionally defined above.

January 25, 2005 U.S. Court of Appeals Rules IRS cannot apply force against a Tax Payer without a Court Order (Schulz v. IRS, Case No. 04-0196-cv) Note: Original case filed in United States District Court, Washington, D.C. as Case #04CV01211 then moved to the United States Court of Appeals. New case number assigned is 04-0196-cv). This may well have been a designed move on the part of Government so harassment could begin on the members of the class involved in the lawsuit. Which has now begun. Members of the class are now being served with notice of Levy on wages, salaries and other income and all without court orders. It would appear the Department of Justice and the IRS have failed to notify field operatives of the courts decision.

On January 1, 2005 I sent a letter to the IRS informing them the reason I did not pay an income tax is because the United States Supreme Court had ruled “income taxes” are unconstitutional. The

letter addressed to a Ms. Tetrison Employee 3505032 at ACS Support - Stop 5050 Kansas City, Mo 64121 Ms. Tetrison failed to advise superiors of my letter and reason for non-payment of the unconstitutional tax. I have now been served with notice of levy because of this incompetent boob. I demand it be withdrawn and my employer Ball Metal notified by no later than June 20, 2005 at 10:00 A.M. or this court finds the IRS in Contempt of the Court with maximum penalties.

I also am aware that the IRS form 1040 has no legal basis in law. So information collected on this form should be thrown out if it is being used against a citizen.

When you call for a supervisor that person will try and make contact with you only once.

Then they leave this number 1-800-829-7650 for you to call back. This number can be connected to any state, any location to any person working for the IRS. If you ask what law requires me to pay an income tax none of them can answer. If you ask to speak to the supervisor they have no clue as to how to connect you. Today I tried to contact the IRS supervisor who called me, it was the biggest piece of garbage, in efficiency, waste of time, money and energy ever developed by the United States Government, Inc. to upset a person. You should call this number for yourself and ask for the law that requires a person to pay an income tax. Just so you can experience this wonderful bull for yourself. I even gave the lady I talked to in Florida today a case number and she still could not get in touch with the supervisor.

## LEFT WING? RIGHT WING? I’M CONFUSED.

A recent US Harris Poll has revealed widespread confusion over the significance of the terms Left and Right politics. I would go further and suggest this confusion is now universal.

The concept is commonly attributed to the Jacobins but that is like saying the tail is the dog. The true source was Thomas Paine, an adoptive American citizen of English origin, and prime contributor to the later abandoned concept of American *Democracy*; and also that of the French Revolution which, too, enjoyed a short life. Nonetheless; forsaking it has not stopped politicians from parading the word *democracy* like a banner ever since. This tragedy was subsequently mourned by Paine, Washington, Smith and Lincoln. Popular literature apparently records this differently.

Anyway, diffuse sources aside, the concept of *left* and *right* quickly came to recognise the fundamental shape of post aristocratic and emerging egalitarian political/ economic power. The all-important focus was *distribution of power*. Thus, those who favoured power in the hands of the select few, the elitists, were to *the right*, and those who preferred to distribute power evenly and fairly amongst the people, the democrats, occupied *the left*. The later-evolving British Westminster compromise was seen to be in the centre.

Simple enough? Not when you add academics and journalists to the equation.

Academics were preoccupied with what politicians *said* they would do; *the theories*. Being essentially elitist themselves, they viewed a certain mode of leadership as benign, natural and necessary. Consequently, anyone who claimed to be ‘bringing equality to the people’ was labeled *left wing*, regardless of methodology or even socio-economic outcome. To this day, many people continue to believe that Karl Marx was a champion of equality when in fact he was implacably opposed to democracy and believed in the ascension of enlightened elites to rule the proletariat. Very clearly, Marx was elitist and *right wing*. Therefore, we should not have been surprised when Marxist/ Communist regimes became dictatorships. They were intended to be. Now we can appreciate the inevitable anguish and disillusionment of ‘left-wing’ students and other activist seekers of justice.

Mass media journalists, on the other hand, were more interested in what

politicians *did*. And, with a predilection to reduce all human activities to the basics of *good* and *evil*, they interpreted accordingly. Their commentaries also tended to incorporate the political leanings of media owners and influential pressure groups. Consequently, in the US, by the end of WWII, with Russia emerging as the perceived threat to US supremacy, *left* became equated with evil and, by default, *right* with good. By the 1950s that most elitist and powerful of all organisations, the Catholic Church, was describing *the left* as the work of Satan; a message that did not fail to reach a Catholic US President.

In the US, with the word *democracy* rapidly becoming synonymous with patriotism, being American and “free”, and even God, *The Right* even more blatantly wielded *Democracy* as its banner, even though the thrust of its policies was unashamedly oligarchic and plutocratic.

Meanwhile, earlier twentieth century Europe and UK, with entirely different political histories, and with powerful trade unions protecting workers rights and political voice, the word *right* became more correctly associated with elitism; Nazism and Fascism. Unfortunately, there too, Communists were seen to occupy the extreme left. European society became divided, with one segment seeing democrats as being *left wing* with conservative elitists to the *right*; another sector confusing democrats, socialists and Christians; and a third group who saw socialists as occupying the left, democrats the centre, and all other groups, including communists and fascists, as flooding the right. And, there was a plethora of cultural interpretations which even more confused the people.

Through all of this, the original focus, the all-important issue of *power distribution*, became diffused or lost altogether.

With considerable organised encouragement, Democracy came to be interpreted as a system whereby the people voted individuals into power, hopefully to represent them; which of course they never did. The concept of the people controlling government was successfully smothered. Essentially, the aristocracy had simply changed uniforms.

Today, absolute confusion reigns. What is left? What is right? What is democracy?

We should stop using what are now meaningless terms. If we want to communicate relative political positions, the more accurate terminology is *Elitist* or *Democrat*.

An *Elitist* supports the concept of government by the few, whilst a *Democrat* favours government by the people, for the people...all of the people. Yeah, right. That rumble we don't hear is journalists and academics rushing to adopt such sensible and meaningful

## The Fight Against La Raza

On Tuesday, 06-21-05, the NFC Steering Committee approved three very important letter templates submitted by the Illegal Immigration Committee. The reason those templates are so important is because the letters concern financial support for a radical group known as La Raza. The following is an example of the first template-letter that will be sent:

Dear Sir or Madam;  
As American Citizens, we are contacting you because it has come to our attention that your (company/organization) has been providing financial support for a group known as La Raza (The Race), web site location: <http://www.laraza.com>. Their name denotes racism. Minimal investigation reveals this group to be promoting extreme racism against American citizens. The United States has been diligent in its efforts to eradicate the racial discrimination that La Raza now promotes. These practices supported by La Raza are outrageous and destructive to the very core values expressed in the Constitution of the United States, and deteriorate our national unity.

La Raza is being supported by another radical group known as La Voz de Aztlan, whose web site can be located at [www.aztlan.net](http://www.aztlan.net). La Voz de Aztlan is actively, and successfully, promoting the invasion, conquest, and secession of portions of the United States. This group has posted a map (see below) on their website that specifically details the areas targeted for conquest. "They form the base of a triangle, above which are the Trilateral Commission, and the Bilderbergers, all working for the same Globalist goals. A few CFR members hold membership in all three, such as Rockefeller, Henry Kissinger and Gerald Ford. Big Banking sits above them all."

What is their immediate plan called FTAA? "This deal has been quietly cooking since 1994 in Globalist circles," Appleton said. "It is called the Free Trade Areas of the Americas. But like the European Union, it has little to do with free trade. Rather, it is about to merge the USA with all other 33 countries of the Americas in a new monstrosity, which will swallow up them all. It is expected to be called The American Union—like the Soviet Union. It presupposes a new governing body to take over the Western Hemisphere. A document entitled "The Declaration of Quebec City," signed after their third conference in April of 2001, shows in Globalist/UN lingo that it involves far more than "Free Trade." It will mean the end of the USA as we have known it, courtesy of our beloved US Congress and Senate who have very few who can be counted on to stand by the Constitution."

How do we reconcile the Presidents talk of "freedom" in all this? "I do not know," Appleton said. "Yet this sounds great in a speech after taking a solemn oath on the Bible to uphold and defend the Constitution of the United State of America. But if it was untrue, something has to give."

Why plunge the US into enormous debt? "Much is related to the War on Terror," Appleton said. "Who profits? If we could profit through a deal like the Federal Reserve Banking System as it collects its interest for shuffling government paper through its office, wouldn't it be wonderful! Instead, we must pay for their sweetheart arrangement. They and their agents play a powerful part in initiating wars, where they make out by first destroying and then rebuilding a land like Iraq.

"But also, I believe they need an America brought to its knees in bankruptcy and in turmoil, begging to receive the salvation offered by their Global schemes. Otherwise, no free citizen in his right mind would give up what we have had for 229 years for a mess of Socialist pottage.

"Just to make sure any disgruntled ones can be legally and efficiently taken care of, they now have their Homeland Security and Patriot Acts I and II to handle them."

What are our chances of reversing these plans? "Very slight," Appleton said. "The legal authority for them to do as they will is well in place, including FEMA and a host of other threats to our freedom.

"A state of emergency can be declared by presidential decree that will turn the code to Red, for as long as it takes. New people are being put into place in top law enforcement, (Alberto Gonzalez) that have questionable backgrounds. Wherever we are heading, there is slight chance of turning back peaceably."

What about Bush's 9/11 Investigation

Commission? "The first person picked was CFR member/agent Henry Kissinger," Appleton said. "His record, a living disaster to U.S. interests, is unparalleled. He made himself the total czar over all intelligence under Nixon. He undoubtedly controlled the secret taping system in the White House that caused Nixon's downfall. He was in charge of all disarmament and recommended that the U.S. seek the best deal with the Soviets to save our necks. His appointment to the Commission by Bush did it for me, as far as intent and integrity goes. "And now Bush has just appointed Negroponte to be the latest czar over all U.S. Intelligence. The CFR web site is [www.terrorismanswers.org](http://www.terrorismanswers.org). They have all the answers that fit what data they wanted released."

What gimmick was used to start the war in Iraq and other places? "We remember the ballyhoo that started Iraq," Appleton said. "It was all a lie because there were no weapons of mass destruction. We all know now, that the story about gunboats in the Gulf of Tonkin attacking our fleet in Vietnam was false. Pearl Harbor was used by Roosevelt to drag us into WWII. The sinking of the liner Lusitania helped to get us into WWI. The explosion of the U.S. Battleship Maine caused the unnecessary war with Spain. Hitler's staged attack on the government in Germany, helped his rise to power. It still works."

What is needed for Americans to accept World Government?
