American Workers: Outsourced/ Offshored To Death

Three Americans died in Colorado last week, victims of our government's failure to protect its employers' — Citizens — jobs and access to healthcare.

The murder-suicide deaths of a Colorado Springs mother and her two young sons left a husband and father without a family. While depression is blamed, the fact is another American breadwinner lost his software engineering job and was forced to relocate to the East Coast to earn a living while his family stayed behind.

When his wife lost her temp job and expressed growing despair, friends called local police who took her to a hospital for evaluation. Jobless, probably without medical insurance, her husband thousands of miles away and aware her children were too young to be alone, she checked herself out of the hospital, bought a handgun, and chose a permanent solution to a growing problem: foreigners taking jobs Americans need with the blessing of our so-called "representatives".

This tragedy occurred as Colorado's Governor Bill Owens

lobbyists and legislators killed a bill to bring home tax-funded, offshored jobs — including programming jobs that might have saved this family.

Senate Bill 05-023, the "Keep Jobs in America Act," would have required Colorado to use tax dollars to hire US workers, ending the State's practice of hiring foreigners.

Introduced in January by State Senator Deanna Hanna (D), SB 05-023 prohibited Colorado from securing services from a contractor/subcontractor using "offshore" foreign-based workers.

The Bill required prospective contractors to certify that all services would be performed in the United States when submitting a bid to a State agency.

Contractors failing to comply with those terms risked contract termination, civil lawsuits, and stiff penalties including damages to the State agency equal to the amount that agency paid for work performed outside of the US, plus damages related to contract termination. Violators would be barred for three years from contacts with Colorado.

SB 05-023 was the legislative outgrowth of a proposed Colorado ballot initiative, "Hire Americans First," which fell short of required signatures last summer. I personally collected 250 signatures, speaking with scores of frustrated, angry Coloradans sick of greedy globalist employment scams paid for with our tax dollars.

Support for this populist initiative crossed political, social, economic, educational and racial lines. Many eager signers had lost jobs to foreign workers. (Last week, Microsoft's Bill Gates demanded the US government issue unlimited visas to foreign high-tech workers.)

Young parents spoke of friends who had been laid off, worried they were next. Middle-aged signers described once-flourishing careers lost to foreigners whom they had been forced to train. Many lamented that their children could not pursue technical training because insourcing/offshoring left a dead end for Americans.

Some expressed valid concerns about security/identity theft intrinsic to offshoring. Foreign workers often have easy, unregulated access to highly sensitive personal information including Social Security numbers, income/assets, bank account records, etc. (In April, police arrested 16 offshored call-center employees in India for allegedly cheating Citibank customers out of nearly \$350,000.)

One woman ushered a young boy into a store and returned to tell me that his father had lost his job and health insurance to a foreigner. That boy's dad died last year, unable to afford treatment for his heart condition.

A few years back, these talented Americans would have been at the peak of their earning power, preparing for comfortable retirements. Today, many eke out a living, clinging to the thin veneer of our shrinking middle-class.

As unpaid volunteers gathered signatures for "Hire Americans First," State of Colorado spokesman, insisted "we" need offshore workers in India and China because they can work when Coloradans

sleep! (These bureaucratic bozos will get a 3% pay increase this year, even though inflation is one-tenth of one percent.)

Hanna's SB 05-023 was a second chance to stop exporting good jobs created and funded by, and for, Colorado's Citizen-taxpayers. Originally deemed to have no fiscal impact upon the State's budget, the bill stalled when Gov. Owens' Dept. of Personnel and Administration announced it would cost the State \$24 million to hire Americans rather than foreigners.

Sen. Hanna calls the \$24 million price tag "bogus," designed to ensure the bill would not survive.

"No one has a clue how many [State] jobs are being offshored, what contracts have offshored jobs, or whether the products purchased have been delivered," she says.

In February, Republican Senator Ron May

who runs a computer consulting firm, said that, "Considering that technical services for the State's IBM main processing unit is located in Asia, and two software packages utilized are made in London and Israel, 'potential increase' would become an assured reality..."

Do tell, Sen. May, what information is stored in "Asian" computers run by "Asian" workers? Who has access to it? How much are we paying for this foreign operation? Are Coloradans — your constituents and employers — too stupid to handle our own high tech needs?

May further claimed that SB 05-023 "will increase costs by depriving citizens of government services at the lowest possible price, decreasing competition among vendors and maintaining a monitoring system."

What do May and others have to say about the State of Colorado's new software package — designed to determine eligibility for Medicaid, Food Stamps and other services? The system, designed by EDS with an unknown number of "offshore" workers, crashed and burned, putting many vulnerable Citizens at risk while costing the State a bundle of our money.

"The offensive part is that offshoring is touted as a way to save money on the backs of the American workers without jobs," says Hanna, who believes auditing offshored projects would reveal significant problems.

“We are spending an inordinate amount of time thinking about tax incentives to bring good jobs to Colorado,” she says. “Why should we use our tax dollars to send jobs out of Colorado?”

Though SB 05-023 was approved by Colorado Senate’s Business, Labor & Technology Committee, Hanna pulled the bill given Gov. Owens’ threat to veto it. Deep-pocket globo-business groups also fought it.

Still, Hanna promises to bring the bill back when more support is available. “The people of Colorado deserve no less,” she says.

FREE TRADE AND MICHIGAN’S FALLING REVENUES

Niles writer, Mark Anderson, has written of the financial woes facing public schools in Brandywine, Niles, Lakeshore, and Berrien Springs school districts. He stated that just as other Michigan school districts are in need of higher revenues, major building improvements and costly new schools are being built using taxpayers’ money in many. Normally, this is not an unusual occurrence. New schools need to be built from time to time and older ones need to be repaired and/or upgraded to meet the needs of students. However, according to Anderson, in many of the districts, school enrollment has declined which has a direct effect on school funding.

It’s a situation that is taking place all across the United States. In Michigan, declining revenues leads to a financial crisis of one magnitude or another which affects public school budgets. As Anderson explained, some want to raise the per-pupil foundation grant to public schools from \$6,700 to \$6,875. However, Anderson believes it may not be raised at all. It’s the state legislature that must

vote on such an increase and they don’t know if the money even exists.

That brings us to an important question raised by Anderson. Why is Michigan, like most states, hurting so badly for revenue?”

While it would be nice to pin the blame solely on poor fiscal management or excessive spending on the part of government, local officials from the county downward (including school officials), Anderson claims we must reject the bloated-budget excuse (even though it may be legitimate). The truth is that spending by those in elected positions has skyrocketed and must be revamped and reduced. Anderson says that schools should tighten their belts, but there is one “sacred cow” he says needs to be “mercilessly gored.” That “cow” is Free Trade.

If Michigan’s Gov. Granholm, and state and local officials cannot create a sound tax base, they must, as Anderson wrote, “pull the plug on the 1993 North American Free Trade Agreement and the 1994 General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade. Furthermore, local officials must demand that Congress not approve the proposed Dominican Republic-Central American Free Trade Agreement (DR-CAFTA) and the granddaddy, the Free Trade Area of the Americas.”

To create a good tax base, the Governor, *et al*, must recognize that those trade agreements do nothing to “nurture a growing, productive economy to increase both the quantity and quality of jobs so each taxpayer pays less but revenues remain healthy.” In fact, those trade agreements have the opposite effect. Anderson says that while most Americans may not be interested in foreign policy, they should “remember that the states created the federal government by scrapping the Articles of Confederation and forming a federal republic under the U.S. Constitution.” They should also understand that “every official, from the local clerk all the way up to the president, takes an oath to uphold and defend the U.S. Constitution. Every ounce of authority granted to Congress comes from the people.”

Anderson also believes that our economy will not become whole again until we stop listening “to the stock free-trade propaganda” that provides only “cookie-cutter answers from Congress and think tanks” — the folks who want us to believe that our economy can only be saved when we open up the foreign markets. “All we have to do, the trade freaks claim, is make stuff and send it away.”

Nice idea on paper, or while

discussed by billionaires and media gatekeepers/agenda setters at country club dinners and Washington banquets, but it has no basis in truth. Quotas and tariffs on our goods have not decreased while our “legitimate tariff system is all but gone.” As Anderson contends, most American industries are suffering under the high costs of government regulations whereby movement of manufacturing and production out of the United States or business closures are not uncommon. The one thing we export tax free, he says, are our jobs. Just try calling your computer company for tech help and ask your tech helper the name of the country in which s/he resides. Rarely, if ever, is the person an American working in America.

According to Anderson, when Bosch closed its Stevensville, operation, they made “vague comments . . . that the same jobs can be performed cheaper elsewhere.” Does that mean anywhere but the United States or does it just mean “China or Mexico?” Along with Bosch, Michigan has lost the “Electrolux plant in Greenville, Watervliet Paper Mill, Clark Equipment, Auto Specialties, and various other industrial concerns. The last two, located in Buchanan and the Twin Cities, caused “the area’s economy” to hum. Anderson says that productive revenue base must be regained. (Of course, one way to destroy American car manufacturing is to create a gas shortage crisis and then convince consumers to buy foreign-made vehicles. Today, those foreign companies are now manufacturing foreign cars in the United States — a great way to spawn an economic Tower of Babel.)

It’s good to know that writers like Mark Anderson still have a voice. A student of the issue for years, he’s invited local social, county, and township (among others) officials to talk with him so he can “explain the utter devastation being wrought on the local, state and national economy by these trade deals.” Local officials, he says, must tell their state and federal representatives that they are concerned and “demand . . . support [for] NAFTA and fully reestablish the Congressional authority, under Article 1, Section 8 of the U.S. Constitution.” That means they must “properly and fairly regulate all trade, instead of outsourcing that authority to the unelected World Trade Organization — a forfeiture of duty forbidden by the Founding Fathers.”

In order to turn things around for this nation, Anderson says “we need bold action.” Without it, “personal and public debt, declining jobs and the falling dollar are going to spell very big trouble.” Anderson also suggests a return to a tariff “on federal revenue” that was in effect for the “first 125 years of the republic.” Our tax burden must be

returned “to those foreign interests that want the privilege of selling their wares in our markets.” The latter solution would eliminate most of the tax burden that’s fallen on American-based industries and American consumers.

Our trade deficit, says Anderson, could be alleviated if Americans were making “shoes, shirts, electronics, and thousands of other durable goods, and [would also] give high school and college graduates great jobs.” It’s not enough to provide job training and tax breaks selectively, Anderson says. American must become “business friendly . . . [and] equal for all . . . so we are “an industrial and technical powerhouse once again. Nothing less will do.”

Have you ever cut your finger while slicing an onion? How about a scrape on your elbow when you fell? Ever suffer sunburn? What happened when you suffered a bloody nose? Have you ever cut a major artery where you could have bled to death?

Today, America bleeds to death by a thousand cuts. We're bleeding from every sector of our society. At some point, the United States of America cannot and will not survive the bleeding. Why? Take a look.

Each day, Americans burn 20 million barrels (55 gallons per barrel) of oil in their cars, but we import over half of that oil from other countries. Therefore, that's $\$2.25 \text{ per gallon} \times 55 = \$123.75 \times 10,000,000 \text{ barrels}$, which equals $\$1,237,500,000.00$ we pay other countries daily. That's money that never returns to America. It's like America cutting its wrist. Meanwhile, we have NO energy conservation policy in America.

Last year, the trade deficit totaled \$618 billion according to the New York Times. It's expected to exceed \$700 billion in 2005. That's money going out that isn't coming into America.

Brian Williams of NBC stated that the Federal deficit will grow another \$383 billion in 2006. Do you feel your pocket-book bleeding?

What about American enterprise? Recently, General Motors and Ford suffered their demotion to Junk Bonds. Ironically, China's Yuan is undervalued because it's tied to the American dollar, but the Yuan will jump when it is ultimately pegged to the Euro. Soon, the Euro will become the new standard for exchange as it displaces the dollar on the international money markets. In the high tech jobs arena, the H-1B, H-2B and L-1 visas were given to over 1,000,000 foreigners to displace American workers. Who is responsible? Your congressman and senators! Go to www.numbersusa.com and check out the report card on your senators or congressman and you'll mostly see F's.

The hemorrhaging accelerates when you realize that our Federal debt stands at \$7.4 trillion. We pay over \$600 million a day in interest payments. Bush bumped the debt ceiling by \$800 million at the first of the year while borrowing \$1.6 billion daily from foreign investors. Their interest rates bleed us further. Is the

fabulously wealthy George Bush paying that interest? No, you are! The rich get richer and you get poorer. Further, you, the average American with a credit card carry an average of \$8,000.00 balance (debt) on your credit card. That equals \$2.0 trillion in consumer debt according to CBS News. Added to that bleeding, you're paying 18 percent APR on that debt credit card debt.

For more bleeding, over 20 million illegals siphon off \$68 billion annually out of your taxpayer pocket as they use our schools, welfare, medical care and services. Folks, they're not just picking lettuce anymore. They're taking jobs away from Americans. Harvard's Professor Borjas of economics showed that illegal aliens displace American workers out of \$200 billion in lost wages annually. We're not talking about a financial nose bleed. We're talking slashed arteries!

All the while, according to a recent Bears and Sterns report, illegals work off the books to the tune of \$400 billion annually in uncollected IRS income taxes. Who makes up that money? You do with the blood, sweat and tears from your working legally in your country. What are the consequences? For starters California with three million illegals stands at \$38 billion in debt and last year, 86 hospitals and ER wards bankrupted. Every single state in America is under horrific financial crisis because of unpaid taxes by illegals and their massive liabilities. What makes it worse; over three million illegals add their illegal working hands to the US workforce annually. Feel your life blood draining?

Home foreclosures and personal bankruptcies stand at an all time high for American citizens. How about the \$80 billion annual price for the ongoing \$30 billion Drug War that has solved nothing? What about the price of a home today that has doubled in 20 years? How about the \$128 billion in cash leaving the USA annually to pay for the drugs coming across the Mexican border? Buying my Dell (TM) laptop computer was such a simple transaction, I was almost convinced that Murphy's Law would intrude with ominous results. When the computer arrived several days later, I was thrilled that my sense of foreboding was unfounded. It took only one month for me to realize that I had been right all along.

Thirty days later, I called Dell's tech help line for assistance with specific software and other minor malfunctions that needed to be addressed. The tech worker was extremely pleasant, even when I asked him where he was located. We talked about India and its new role in the American tech market. Then, with the skill of a leopard stalking its prey, he told me he couldn't help me unless I renewed my tech-help contract for a paltry \$29.95. He said he would gladly handle the transaction for me if I would give him a credit or debit card number. I smelled a rat . . . and rightfully so. My computer came with an extended warranty that included home repair for which I had paid dearly as part of the purchase package. However, I believed him (to a point) and didn't know for 15 months that my extended contract was still alive, well, and unused.

For 15 months I fought my way through malfunction after malfunction (mostly caused by spyware) and never called Dell until I was hit with a \$92 repair bill and months of frustration. That was the last straw. When told the customer service representative, a lovely Malaysian woman, the story, I still believed my warranty was long over. I was told it was good through August 2005. Talk about stunned . . . I was furious that I had been lied to so egregiously. It took two months of phone calls and two home repairs to find out that my computer was dead and would be replaced by Dell, but nothing was ever done about the fraudulent statements made to me by an offshore employee nor were the 15 months of warranty I'd lost ever reinstated. Evidently, federal laws forbid such restoration even when the loss is caused by the attempted crime of an offshore worker.

It's bad enough that we're buying so many cheap products that are manu-

factured overseas by slave labor. Now we have to deal with foreign teckies. I fought long and hard to deal with Americans working for Dell in Austin, TX. I believe, but can't prove, that they complied. The experience has taught me to stop doing business with those who value globalization and the almighty dollar over the economic well-being of this nation and its citizens. Dell will never get my business again nor will any company that has tossed the American worker aside for cheap or slave labor, especially if their ethical standards do not have to comply with what remains of our godly American ethics and laws.

THERE'S NOTHING FREE ABOUT FREE TRADE AGREEMENTS

Since NAFTA was passed in 1994, 7.8 million jobs have been lost in the manufacturing sector. H-1B VISA SCAM ON AMERICAN WORKERS

Our elected officials in Washington, DC take an oath of office to 'defend and protect' American citizens. Senators and Representatives pledge their honor to work for the benefit of their American constituents who voted them into office. However, today, after one decade, 890,000 high tech American citizens were forced to train foreign workers and then were fired via the H-1B visa program. In 2000, not satisfied with 115,000 visas per year, Congress increased the annual quota to more than 195,000 visas. That visa is why you hear a foreign voice with broken English when you call for high tech help.

It's your clue that another American citizen is out of work.

Millions of college-trained American citizens have suffered unemployment via Congressional actions. While employers raise the false claim that positions are being "offshored," in reality, immigrants from nations such as India, China, and Russia are displacing American citizens while eroding American wage scales. Simultaneously, the economic elite, who capture most of the value added by these professionals, are experiencing unprecedented increases in their personal wealth – as working American's economic stability teeters on the brink.

Editors Note: The same thing occurred in the 1800s as covered in the book *The Coming Battle*

Hundreds of thousands of American citizen recent college graduates are unable to find work. Instead, they are being forced to take low-skill positions that make scant use of their training. Is this the America we aspire to? Many still live, uninsured, with their parents. Employers covet the "fresh cheap young blood" from Third World nations, instead.

Government leaders trumpet "rising productivity" and continue to suggest that job creation will eventually catch up with population growth. The grim reality is that millions of jobs have been cut since 2000. Those visa holders are "officially" working only eight hours per day. Thus, having millions of these people working as indentured servants in exchange for potential employer "green card" sponsorship results in tens of millions of hours per

year of uncompensated overtime - an employer windfall worth billions.

Nobel Prize winner Milton Friedman described the H-1B visa program as another government subsidy (to employers) in 2002. How many more subsidies can we afford? Highly skilled and experienced professionals with PhDs and two decades of "high tech" employment are told by employers they are "overqualified." This thinly-disguised illegal employment discrimination on the basis of age and national origin has meant that many Americans have been seeking full-time employment since 2001. (One employer, Genuity, Inc. retained its special visa holders while axing the jobs of hundreds of American citizens.)

It should be clear by now that these special visa programs, which are a form of corporate welfare, often as a quid-pro-quo for generous campaign contributions, are destroying America as a participatory democracy. Plutocracy is becoming the power behind many government leaders.

A BRIEF HISTORY

The history of these employer-designed "cheap labor" programs includes many ethical lapses. The H visa was created in 1952 to give "special handling" to western range-land owners who wanted inexpensive imported shearers. The term "special handling" means that employers don't have to attest that they are usurping American citizen's access to jobs. In 1976, in response to still undisclosed considerations, the Association of American Universities (AAU) successfully lobbied U.S. Representative Joshua Eilberg for the passage of the "Eilberg Amendment" which granted universities special handling for college professors and researchers. AAU members imported unprecedented numbers of these skilled professionals at bargain-basement prices, since the employer could sponsor the special visa holder for permanent residency after six years of quasi-slave labor. These colleges cut off the chance for bright, dedicated American citizens to pursue a career in research or teaching. Instead, some worked in those fields for a total of six years, but were discarded by employers like yesterday's newspaper.

Even more shocking, employers are now importing people to work in very sensitive positions affecting our nation's infrastructure and national defense. Non-American workers are teaching our young people in elementary schools - and teaching some very un-American values, (such as how unimportant women are, based on the entrenched cultures of India, Middle East and mainland China) to their receptive young charges.

IMPORTING POVERTY

The goal of most employers is clear. Drive down U.S. wages with labor gluts that result from removing all protections against displacement by desperate Third World wage earners.

OUR NEXT STEPS

What can be done to equalize the power of American citizens against these "robber barons?" The first step is to widely circulate information like this article. The opposition annually spends millions of dollars in sophisticated public relations campaigns. American citizens, harnessing the power of the Internet, can counteract their propaganda.

Joining organizations such as WashTech.com, NAEA.US, NumbersUSA.com and FAIRUS.ORG gives you access to citizen empowerment tools to take back this democracy before it is too late. The leadership of reformers such as U.S. Representative Tom Tancredo should be supported and encouraged. We hope it does not take bloody street riots to re-establish American democracy.
