Our reflectors are open to all responsible patriots and we invite you to share with us your ideas about making our country the great nation that it should be.

- 1) Every member has an equal opportunity for expression and dialogue.
- 2) Freedom of expression is to include common courtesy to every member.
- 3) No profanity.
- 4) No cross-posting.
- 5) Personal attacks, for the purpose of harassment, will not be tolerated.
- 6) All advertising must be cleared through the Steering Committee.
- 7) No pornography.
