05-10-2005 Minutes:

Motion: David Denny made a motion that the minutes from the
05-10-2005 meeting of the NFC Steering Committee be
approved as Secretary Robert Williams presented them to the
Steering Committee members via temporary website posting.
Virginia Brooks seconded, and the motion carried,
unanimously.

REPORTS:

Treasurer's Report:

Temporary Treasurer, Virginia Brooks' reported having
nothing to report at this time.

Previous NFC Treasurer update:

Temporary NFC Treasurer, Virginia Brooks reported that the
previous NFC Treasurer, Connie Webster, had contacted her
and informed her that she would close the old NFC bank and
PayPal accounts, and send the balance of the NFC account to
her as soon as she is able to go to the bank.

Bank and PayPal accounts:

Chairman, Richard Green reported opening a savings and
checking account with his credit union in the name of New
Frontier Leadership Consensus. These accounts were
established for New Frontier Coalition use. A PayPal
account may now be linked to the checking account.

Website Report:

NFC website consultant, Yvonne Stratton, reported that the NFC website passwords have now been provided to David Denny for the purpose of updating and maintaining the NFC website.

Any new website contacts will automatically be forwarded to Richard Green, Virginia Brooks, and Robert Williams for follow-up and permanent recording.

Yvonne Stratton also reported having already establishing a PayPal account and would work in conjunction with Richard Green to establish a connection with the new checking account.

Bell Icon:

Motion: Robert Williams made a motion to allow David Denny to proceed with changing the Bell Icon on the NFC website to an icon of his choosing and approve the change in the next SC meeting. Richard Green seconded, and the motion carried, unanimously.

Motion: Robert Williams made a motion to allow the webmaster to make changes in the "News Item" section of the NFC web page as needed. Virginia Brooks seconded, and the motion carried, with one abstention.

Notice of Official Website Opening:

Tabled: Without a motion, but by general agreement, official opening of the NFC website will be postponed until the website has reached completion and is fully functional.

NFC Newsletter Report:

Virginia Brooks reported that, with the exception of the Illegal Immigration Committee update, she has received all of the necessary articles for the June newsletter.

Illegal Immigration Committee Report:

Committee Chairman, Robert Williams reported that the Illegal Immigration Committee met on May 12, and is scheduled to meet again on Thursday, May 19, 2005. The cover to the Citizen's Handbook is complete and work is in progress on the content. A tri-fold handout is being developed and should be ready within a week. Handouts are also being designed. A proposed third-party illegal

immigration alliance is in early stages of planning. A letter-writing campaign is being established against the financial supporters of La Raza... as well as other projects. The IIC request that Jill Walker and Richard Green use their expertise and influence to publicize our projects to the public.

The IIC recommends the following statement be accepted and used as an official NFC Statement of Position:

We, the members of the New Frontier Coalition, hold that the Republican and Democratic Parties of these United States have utterly failed to uphold their Constitutional duty by both allowing and promoting the invasion of illegal aliens into our country. We further believe that all illegal aliens should be immediately deported.

It is the intent of the New Frontier Coalition to educate the United States Citizen as to the internal threat placed on our education, health care, and standard of life that this massive invasion currently poses. Our goal is to endorse and promote political candidates that will stop this invasion and start the immediate deportation of all illegal aliens.

Motion: David Denny made a motion for the NFC Steering Committee to adopt the proposed Illegal Immigration Committee statement as presented. Virginia Brooks seconded and the motion carried, unanimously.

Dan Karias informed the SC that there is a petition in circulation to nominate CNN news host, Lou Dobbs for President. Dan thought that an interesting possibility might be to support both Lou Dobbs and Jim Gilchrist (minuteman project) for President and vice-President.
