Illegal Immigration Committee Report:

Committee Chairman, Robert Williams reported that the Illegal Immigration Committee met on May 19, and is scheduled to meet again on Thursday, May 26, 2005. The cover to the Citizen's Handbook is complete and work is in progress on the first 10 pages of the content. A tri-fold handout and full-page handouts are near completion. A proposed third-party illegal immigration alliance is still being planned. The 1st of three letters is complete for a letter-writing campaign that has been established against the financial supporters of La Raza. Additional projects are under consideration.
